

Literacy Corner



Dear PAMS Parents,

I have spent the past few months writing to you about the importance of reading, and it is certainly a key component of any child or adult's ongoing education. An often overlooked element of literacy, however, is conversation. We lead very busy lives—in school, at work, and at home. Couple that with the amount of time many adults and children spend on devices, and "poof"

conversation fades away. This month I'd like to direct you to a site advocating "The Family Dinner Project." Here's a little bit from them about their purpose:

The Family Dinner Project is a growing movement of food, fun and conversation about things that matter. We are a nonprofit organization currently operating from the offices of Project Zero at Harvard University.

Over the past 15 years, research has shown what parents have known for a long time: Sharing a fun family meal is good for the spirit, brain and health of all family members.

Recent studies link regular family meals with the kinds of behaviors that parents want for their children: higher grade-point averages, resilience and self-esteem. Additionally, family meals are linked to lower rates of substance abuse, teen pregnancy, eating disorders and depression. We also believe in the power of family dinners to nourish ethical thinking.


to request a peer tutor. It can be as short as a few sessions to prepare for a test or as long as a quarter to reinforce and review throughout the reporting period.

School Store


The school store is located in the Library Media Center and is open daily from 8:55am until 9:10am. Supplies include: pen-
